AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, 2 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto, "further providing for the removal and impositions 5 of limitations on certain deposits and further providing for 6 authorizing investments. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Clause (iii) of subsection (d) of section 1705.1, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First 10 11 Class Township Code, " reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and amended July 3, 1980 (P.L.374, No.94), is 12 amended and clauses are added to read: 13 14 Section 1705.1. Investment of Township Funds. -- * * * 15 (d) Authorized types of investments for township funds shall 16 be: 17 (iii) Deposits in savings accounts or time deposits, other 18

- 1 than certificates of deposit, or share accounts of institutions
- 2 <u>having their principal place of business in the Commonwealth and</u> <-
- 3 insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or the
- 4 Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation or the National
- 5 Credit Union Share Insurance Fund or the Pennsylvania Deposit
- 6 Insurance Corporation or the Pennsylvania Savings Association
- 7 Insurance Corporation to the extent that such accounts are so
- 8 insured, and, for any amounts above the insured maximum,
- 9 provided that approved collateral as provided by law therefore
- 10 shall be pledged by the depository.

- 12 (vi) Certificates of deposit purchased from institutions
- 13 having their principal place of business in the Commonwealth and
- 14 <u>insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or the</u>
- 15 Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation or the National
- 16 Credit Union Share Insurance Fund or the Pennsylvania Deposit
- 17 Insurance Corporation or the Pennsylvania Savings Association
- 18 Insurance Corporation to the extent that such accounts are so
- 19 insured, however, for any amounts above the insured maximum,
- 20 such certificates of deposit need not be collateralized. SHALL
- 21 BE COLLATERALIZED BY A PLEDGE OR ASSIGNMENT OF ASSETS OF THE
- 22 INSTITUTION, AND SUCH COLLATERAL MAY INCLUDE LOANS (INCLUDING
- 23 INTEREST IN POOLS OF LOANS) SECURED BY FIRST MORTGAGE LIENS ON
- 24 REAL PROPERTY. Certificates of deposit purchased from commercial
- 25 <u>banks shall be limited to an amount equal to twenty percent of a</u>
- 26 <u>bank's total capital and surplus. Certificates of deposit</u>
- 27 purchased from savings and loan associations or savings banks
- 28 shall be limited to an amount equal to twenty percent of an
- 29 <u>institution's assets minus liabilities.</u>
- (vii) Any investment authorized by 20 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73

- 1 (relating to fiduciaries investments) shall be an authorized
- 2 <u>investment for any pension or retirement fund.</u>

- 4 Section 2. The amendments affecting clauses (iii) and (vi)
- of subsection (d) of section 1705.1 shall take effect in 60 5
- 6 days. The amendment affecting clause (vii) of subsection (d) of
- 7 section 1705.1 shall take effect immediately and be retroactive
- 8 to September 3, 1980.
