AN ACT

1 Providing for adoption of capital projects to be financed from
2 current revenues of the Motor License Fund.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Short title.

6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Highway
7 Capital Budget Act for Fiscal Year 1981-1982."

8 Section 2. Itemization and authorization of Highway and Safety
9 Improvement Projects.

10 The 1981-1982 capital budget projects in the category of
11 Highway and Safety Improvement Projects to be financed from
12 current revenues of the Motor License Fund, are hereby itemized
13 by base construction, land or design phase together with their
14 respective estimated costs, as follows:

10 Section 3. Funding limits.

11 (a) Since the estimated costs of the projects authorized in
12 section 2 are based on current dollar values, these estimates
13 may be adjusted to reflect escalation from the effective date of
14 this act to the date of awarding of the construction contracts,
15 as reflected in the Federal Highway Administration Composite
16 Construction Cost Index of the United States Department of
17 Commerce.

18 (b) Actual cash expenditures for the projects itemized in
19 section 2 are to be limited in any given fiscal year to the
20 funding available in the appropriations of the annual operating
21 budget of the Department of Transportation.

22 Section 4. Progress reports.

23 The Secretary of Transportation shall submit a progress
24 report on all projects in this act July 1 of each year to the
25 Governor, the Chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of the
26 Senate and the House of Representatives and to the Chairman of
27 the Senate Transportation Committee and the Chairman of the
28 House of Representatives Transportation Committee. The report
29 shall indicate the latest estimated or actual financial costs,
30 the date of approval by the State Transportation Commission of

1 any program changes, the sources of funds to be used to pay the
2 estimated financial costs and the reallocations of funds made
3 pursuant to section 3. The report also shall indicate those
4 projects contracted for during the preceding period for which
5 Federal funds were or will be obtained, indicate the amount of
6 the contracts and the amount of Federal funds for each and also
7 those projects for which Federal funds cannot be obtained under
8 Federal law.

9 Section 5. Matching Federal funds.

10 State funds shall not be expended in lieu of available
11 Federal matching funds on any projects qualifying for the latter
12 except with the approval of the General Assembly.

13 Section 6. Expiration date.

14 All project phase authorization itemized herein shall expire
15 eight years after the date of enactment, except for those
16 project phases completed, under contract for design or
17 construction, or for which the department has initiated land
18 acquisition by making an offer to purchase land or has initiated
19 condemnation proceedings or has claims in litigation.

20 Section 7. Effective date.

21 This act shall take effect July 1, 1981, or if enacted
22 subsequently, immediately.
