## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for exemption from fees on
- 3 certain transfers.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1902 of Title 75, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 1902. Exemptions from other fees.
- 10 No fee shall be charged under this title for or to any of the
- 11 following:
- 12 (1) A certificate of title returned to the department
- 13 for cancellation.
- 14 (2) The replacement of a registration card or plate,
- driver's license, learner's permit or certificate of title
- lost in the mail if the applicant files an affidavit of
- 17 nonreceipt within 45 days of the date of original issuance.
- 18 (3) A certificate of junk.

- 1 (4) A certificate of rejection.
- 2 (5) A special hauling permit issued to any person
- 3 hauling equipment or materials for use on a Federal or State
- 4 emergency relief project.
- 5 (6) A manufacturer, jobber or dealer for a certificate
- of title to a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer when
- 7 assignment of certificate of title accompanies the
- 8 application for certificate of title, and when the dealer,
- 9 manufacturer or jobber is possessed of current
- 10 manufacturer's, dealer's or jobber's registration plates.
- 11 (7) A transfer to a surviving spouse of a certificate of
- 12 <u>title pursuant to section 1114(b) (relating to transfer of</u>
- vehicle by operation of law).
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
