## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 15 16 16 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17 17	Amending the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, No.284), entitled  "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for occupational disease contracted by an employe arising out of and in the course of employment; establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation thereunder; imposing duties on the Department of Labor and Industry, the Workmen's Compensation Board, Workmen's Compensation Referees, and deans of medical schools; creating a medical board to determine controverted medical issues; establishing an Occupational Disease Fund in custody of the State Workmen's Insurance Board; imposing upon the Commonwealth a part of the compensation payable for certain occupational diseases; making an appropriation; and prescribing penalties, "further providing for burial compensation.
L6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
L7	hereby enacts as follows:
L8	Section 1. The act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, No.284), known
L9	as "The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act," is amended by
20	adding a section to read:
21	Section 307.1. In case of death not resulting from
22	occupational disease, where the decedent had at any time been

awarded compensation under this act for disability due to

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- 1 <u>silicosis</u>, anthraco-silicosis or coal worker's pneumoconiosis,
- 2 the Commonwealth shall pay the sum of seven hundred and fifty
- 3 dollars as burial expenses, in accordance with clause 8 of
- 4 section 307. This sum shall be paid regardless of the period of
- 5 time between the decedent's death and his last exposure to the
- 6 hazard, and shall be paid within 60 days of the receipt of the
- 7 <u>claim by the department.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
- 9 apply to deaths occurring on and after the date of final
- 10 enactment.
