## AN ACT

Providing for the adoption of additional capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Itemization and adoption of additional projects.
Additional 1981-1982 Capital Budget projects in the category of public improvement projects, to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund pursuant to executive authorizations and to be acquired by the Pennsylvania Game Commission are hereby itemized with these estimated costs, as follows:
