AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," extending the reporting period to the
6 Secretary of Revenue for personal income information.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 2514.1, act of March
10 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of
11 1949," added June 30, 1980 (P.L.279, No.80), is amended to read:

12 Section 2514.1. Personal Income Valuation Information and
13 Determinations.--(a) The Secretary of Revenue shall, on or
14 before January 31 of each year commencing in 1981, supply to
15 each school district a listing of the addresses of each person
16 who has filed a State income tax return with the Department of
17 Revenue for the tax year preceding the immediate prior year and
18 has designated thereon a code or identification number
19 indicating that the taxpayer was a resident of the school

1 district at the close of the tax year for which the return was
2 filed. Within [twenty (20)] twenty-five (25) days of receipt of
3 the list, each school district shall report to the Secretary of
4 Revenue in writing in such form as the secretary shall prescribe
5 any claimed corrections to the list as of December 31 of the tax
6 year for which the returns were filed, specifying the basis for
7 each claim. Should the school district claim that any address
8 listed properly should be carried upon the list of another
9 school district, the reporting school district shall notify the
10 other school district of its claim, and a copy of the notice
11 shall accompany the report hereby required. Within ten (10) days
12 of receipt of the notice, the other school district may notify
13 the Secretary of Revenue in writing in such form as the
14 secretary shall prescribe of its nonconcurrence with the claim
15 made by the reporting school district, specifying the basis for
16 its nonconcurrence. Failure to report or notify the Secretary of
17 Revenue of any claimed correction or nonconcurrence as herein
18 provided shall be deemed a concurrence.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
