- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 16, 1891 (P.L.300, No.230),
- 8 entitled "An act to relieve employes from certain prosecutions
- 9 and punishments for conspiracy, under common law or under the
- 10 criminal laws of this Commonwealth," is repealed.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
