16	"Delinquent act."
17	(1) The term means an act designated a crime under the
18	law of this Commonwealth, or of another state if the act

occurred in that state, or under Federal law, or under local
 ordinances.

Revocation or suspension of operating privilege. * * * 14 15 (b) Suspension. --16 (1) The department shall suspend the operating privilege of any driver for one year upon receiving a certified record 17 18 of the driver's conviction in the same proceeding of violating the provisions of § 3731 (relating to driving under 19 20 influence of alcohol or controlled substance) and 18 Pa.C.S. § 6308 (relating to purchase, consumption, possession or 21 transportation of intoxicating beverages). 22 23 [(1)] (2) The department shall suspend the operating privilege of any driver for six months upon receiving a 24 certified record of the driver's conviction of any offense 25 26 under the following provisions: 27 Section 3367 (relating to racing on highways). 28 Section 3731 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance). 29 30 Section 3733 (relating to fleeing or attempting to 19810H1951B2368 - 2 -

Section 3743 (relating to accidents involving damage

[(2)] (3) The department shall suspend the operating
privilege of any driver for six months upon receiving a
certified record of the driver's conviction of a subsequent
offense under the following provisions:

Section 1501(a) (relating to drivers required to be licensed).

Section 1543 (relating to driving while operatingprivilege is suspended or revoked).

14 [(3)] (4) This subsection does not effect an additional 15 period of revocation of the operating privileges of a driver 16 who receives an additional period of revocation for a second 17 or subsequent violation of section 1543.

18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
