AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 9 10 11 elections, providing access to polling places to physically 12 handicapped and elderly voters. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 526, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, Section 1. 16 No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended 17 by adding a subsection to read: Section 526. Polling Places to Be Selected by County 18 19 Board. --20 21 (c) Each polling place shall be free of architectural

barriers and shall have at least one entrance that provides

- 1 access by ramp or otherwise to physically handicapped or elderly

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1983.
