4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
7	No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
8	amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 6163. Manufacture and sale of bullets.
10	A person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree if
11	he knowingly manufacturers, sells or delivers bullets coated
12	with teflon or any like substance which would penetrate body
13	armor worn by law enforcement officers.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
