AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled 1 2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," 5 providing for the time certain officers take office. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 401, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," is amended to read: 10 Enumeration of Elected Officers. -- * * * 11 Section 401. 12 (b) All such officers shall be elected at the municipal election next preceding the expiration of the terms of the 13 14 officers now in office, and quadrennially thereafter, and shall 15 hold their offices for a term of four years from the first Monday of [January] <u>December</u> next after their election and until 16 17 their successors shall be duly qualified, but in the event that 18 any such officer so elected, excepting a county commissioner or

auditor, shall fail to qualify, or if no successor shall be

- 1 elected, then the officer then in office shall continue in
- 2 office only until the first Monday of [January] <u>December</u>
- 3 following the next municipal election, at which time his
- 4 successor shall be elected for a term of four years. In the case
- 5 of a county commissioner or auditor, there shall be a vacancy
- 6 which shall be filled as provided in this act.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
