12	Section 1801. Fiscal YearThe fiscal year of each city
13	shall begin on the first day of January: Provided, That the
14	legislative body of any city may by ordinance fix the fiscal
15	year of such city to begin on the first day of July instead of
16	<u>the first day of January</u> .
17	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
