AN ACT

Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the rates to be charged to certain utility customers.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 66, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
amended by adding a section to read:
<u>§ 1315. Residential rates for certain consumers.</u>
Any public utility as defined in paragraph (1)(i), (ii), (vi)
or (vii) of the definition of "public utility" in section 102
(relating to definitions) which furnishes utility service to any
volunteer fire company, ambulance company or rescue squad or any
combination thereof shall assess the charge for the public
utility service on the basis of its filed residential rate
<u>schedule.</u>
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
