In the House of Representatives, September 15, 1981

1 WHEREAS, GSA Project 948.12 for the construction of an
2 extension of the Main Capitol Building consisting of two parking
3 levels and one office level for the use of the General Assembly
4 is slated to get underway in November; and

5 WHEREAS, Economic conditions suggest that a later date might
6 be more judicious in the face of high interest rates and other
7 pressing needs of the State government; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives requests that
9 Governor Dick Thornburgh and Secretary of General Services
10 Walter Baran hold up commencement of the extension of the Main
11 Capitol Building, GSA Project 948.12, for at least a year
12 pending a better economic climate; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor
14 Dick Thornburgh and Secretary of General Services Walter Baran.
