In the House of Representatives,

1 WHEREAS, The Army Corps of Engineers is currently undertaking  
2 a study of the operation and maintenance of the Allegheny River, <—  
3 MONONGAHELA AND OHIO RIVERS Navigation ~~System~~ SYSTEMS; and <—

4 WHEREAS, There is a possibility that the level of operation  
5 may be reduced; and

6 WHEREAS, The economy of Southwestern Pennsylvania depends  
7 heavily on the Allegheny River, MONONGAHELA AND OHIO RIVERS <—  
8 Navigation ~~System~~ SYSTEMS; and <—

9 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth needs every advantage possible to  
10 keep and create jobs; and

11 WHEREAS, Barge service is necessary for transportation of raw  
12 materials for the steel and construction industries, vital  
13 sections of the Southwestern Pennsylvania economy; and

14 WHEREAS, Barge service carries coal and fuel oil necessary  
15 for heating Pennsylvania homes and businesses; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED (The Senate concurring), That the General Assembly  
17 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of

1 the United States to oppose any reduction of the level of  
2 operation of the Allegheny ~~River~~, MONONGAHELA AND OHIO RIVERS <—  
3 Navigation ~~System~~ SYSTEMS; and be it further <—  
4 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to both  
5 United States Senators and every member of the House of  
6 Representatives from Pennsylvania.
