AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, 3 and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of the first and second classes including those within a county 5 of the second class and counties of the second class A through eighth classes, individually or jointly, to plan 7 their development and to govern the same by zoning, subdivision and land development ordinances, planned 8 9 residential development and other ordinances, by official 10 maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public purpose and by the acquisition of such land; to promote the 11 12 conservation of energy through the use of planning practices 13 and to promote the effective utilization of renewable energy 14 sources; providing for the establishment of planning 15 commissions, planning departments, planning committees and 16 zoning hearing boards, authorizing them to charge fees, make 17 inspections and hold public hearings; providing for 18 appropriations, appeals to courts and penalties for violations; and repealing acts and parts of acts," 19 20 prohibiting zoning ordinances which exclude or restrict 21 amateur radio antennas or towers. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 23 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known 24 25 as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, is amended by 26 adding a section to read:
- 27 <u>Section 603.1. Ordinance Excluding Amateur Radio Antennas</u>

- and Towers Prohibited. -- No zoning ordinance shall exclude or 1
- 2 restrict the erection, location or height of an amateur radio
- 3 antenna, or the tower supporting such antenna. An ordinance may
- 4 regulate the construction or maintenance of an antenna tower,
- 5 but only to the extent as is necessary to protect life or
- 6 property.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months.
