AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1323, No.373), entitled
 "An act concerning notaries public; and amending, revising,
 consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," further
 providing for seals; AND MAKING REPEALS.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 12 of the act of August 21, 1953
- 8 (P.L.1323, No.373), known as The Notary Public Law, is amended
- 9 to read:
- 10 Section 12. Notarial Seal.--[Every notary shall provide a
- 11 public notarial seal with which he shall authenticate all his
- 12 acts, instruments and attestations. There shall be engraved on
- 13 such seal the words "Notary Public, Commonwealth of
- 14 Pennsylvania, and the name and surname of the notary.] (a) A
- 15 notary public shall provide and keep an official seal which HE
- 16 SHALL USE TO AUTHENTICATE ALL HIS ACTS, INSTRUMENTS AND
- 17 ATTESTATIONS. THE SEAL shall be a rubber stamp and shall show
- 18 clearly in the following order: the words "Official Seal,

- 1 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania"; the name and surname of the
- 2 <u>notary and the words "Notary Public"; the name of the political</u>
- 3 <u>subdivision and county in which the notary maintains an office;</u>
- 4 and the date the notary's commission expires.
- 5 (b) The seal shall have a maximum height of one (1) inch and
- 6 width of three and one-half (3 1/2) inches, with a plain border.
- 7 <u>It shall be stamped in a prominent place on the official</u>
- 8 notarial act under the notary's signature in such a manner as to
- 9 <u>be capable of photographic reproduction</u>.
- 10 (c) A notary public shall also provide and keep an embosser
- 11 to authenticate all notarial acts, all instruments and all
- 12 attestations. There shall be engraved on such embosser the words
- 13 "Notary Public, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania," and the name and
- 14 surname of the notary.
- 15 (d) All documents executed shall bear opposite the jurat the
- 16 official seal referred to in subsection (a) and a legibly
- 17 <u>embossed impression.</u>
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
- 19 (C) IN ADDITION TO THE OFFICIAL SEAL REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION
- 20 (A), A NOTARY PUBLIC SHALL ALSO USE AND KEEP AN EMBOSSER UPON
- 21 WHICH SHALL BE ENGRAVED THE WORDS "NOTARY PUBLIC, COMMONWEALTH
- 22 OF PENNSYLVANIA, " AND THE NAME AND SURNAME OF THE NOTARY. ALL
- 23 DOCUMENTS EXECUTED SHALL BEAR OPPOSITE THE JURAT A LEGIBLY
- 24 EMBOSSED IMPRESSION.
- 25 SECTION 2. SECTIONS 13 AND 14 OF THE ACT ARE REPEALED.
- 26 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 90 DAYS.
