AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for issuance and display of
3 registration plates.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1331 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 1331. Issuance of registration plates.

9 * * *

10 (f) Two plates.--Effective January 1, 1988, the department
11 shall furnish two registration plates to every owner whose motor
12 vehicle is registered and for each registration applied for by a
13 manufacturer, jobber or dealer of motor vehicles, and one
14 registration plate to every owner of a registered trailer,
15 semitrailer, motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
16 pedalcycle or pedalcycle with motor attached and for each
17 registration applied for by a manufacturer, jobber or dealer of
18 motorcycles or pedalcycles with motor attached. Except as

1 otherwise provided in this subsection, as used in this title the
2 terms "registration plate" or "plate" include registration
3 plates or plates.

4 Section 2. Section 1332 of Title 75 is amended by adding a
5 subsection to read:

6 § 1332. Display of registration plate.

7 * * *

8 (c) Two plates.--Effective January 1, 1988, when two
9 registration plates are required for a vehicle, one shall be
10 displayed on the front and one on the rear of the vehicle.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
