## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 29. Public assistance program.
- 10 In order to promote the welfare and happiness of all the
- 11 people of the Commonwealth, the Commonwealth shall annually
- 12 provide adequate public assistance to all of its needy,
- 13 <u>distressed</u> and <u>disadvantaged</u>. This assistance shall be at a
- 14 level which is at least 125% of the Lower Living Standard as
- 15 established by the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics. The
- 16 public assistance programs shall be administered promptly and
- 17 humanely with due regard for the preservation of family life and

1 so as to encourage the self-respect of its recipients.
