AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 19, 1974 (P.L.489, No.176), entitled 2 "An act providing for a compensation system for persons 3 injured in motor vehicle accidents; requiring insurance for 4 all motor vehicles required to be registered in Pennsylvania; 5 defining compensable damage in motor vehicle accident cases; establishing an assigned claims plan; providing for 7 arbitration; imposing powers and duties on courts, the Department of Transportation and the Insurance Commissioner; 8 9 prohibiting certain discrimination; and providing penalties," 10 providing for uniform insurance rates.
- 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 12 hereby enacts as follows:
- 13 Section 1. Section 109(a) of the act of July 19, 1974
- 14 (P.L.489, No.176), known as the Pennsylvania No-fault Motor
- Vehicle Insurance Act, is amended to read:
- 16 § 109. Rates.
- 17 Rates and rating. -- The commissioner shall regulate
- obligors providing security covering a motor vehicle in this 18
- Commonwealth. The rates charged for security shall be 19
- [established, determined, and modified only in accordance with 20

- 1 the provisions of the applicable rating law of this
- 2 Commonwealth] uniform for the entire Commonwealth and for all
- 3 <u>drivers</u>, as established by the commissioner.

- 5 Section 2. This act shall apply to all contracts for
- 6 security issued or renewed on and after the effective date
- 7 hereof.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in six months.
