Making appropriations to The Medical College of Pennsylvania, 1 East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. 2 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 4 5 Section 1. The sum of \$2,326,000 is hereby appropriated to 6 The Medical College of Pennsylvania located in East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1984 to 7 June 30, 1985, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program 8 9 and for participation by a representative of the institution, 10 appointed by the Chief Executive Officer thereof, as a member of the Pennsylvania Academic Commission on Technological 11 Development, a commission for inter-institutional communication 12 13 regarding technological innovation and development and for 14 dissemination of information on such matters to the Pennsylvania 15 business community and others who may use such information for 16 new business and job development in Pennsylvania, such commission to be composed of representatives of every State-17 owned or State-related educational or scientific institution 18 receiving General Fund assistance from the Commonwealth. 19 20 Section 2. The sum of 268,000 is hereby appropriated to The Medical College of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for 21 the fiscal year July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985, for the general 22 maintenance of The Medical College of Pennsylvania, including 23 the School of Allied Health, and student aid. 24 25 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania on account of the appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2 26

27 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the 28 basis of costs during the fiscal year.

29 Section 4. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall provide

such information and in such form and manner as the Department
 of Education may prescribe.

Section 5. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report
its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975," without
exception.

9 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1984 or, if10 enacted subsequent to that date, then immediately.
