AN ACT

- 1 Providing procedures for the expenditure of moneys in coal producing counties.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Procedure upon implementation.
- 6 Upon implementation of a permanent regulatory scheme in this
- 7 Commonwealth in accordance with the Federal Surface Mining
- 8 Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (Public Law 95 87, 91 Stat.
- 9 445), all moneys MONEYS received by the Commonwealth from the
- 10 Abandoned Mine Land Fund PURSUANT TO TITLE IV OF THE FEDERAL
- 11 SURFACE MINING CONTROL AND RECLAMATION ACT OF 1977 (PUBLIC LAW
- 12 95-87, 91 STAT. 445) representing the State's share shall be
- 13 expended to effectuate mine reclamation within each coal
- 14 producing county, at the same ratio at which fees were collected
- 15 from that county. Moneys expended shall be in shares directly
- 16 proportionate to the moneys contributed on a per-county basis,

- 1 PROVIDED SUCH MONEYS SHALL BE EXPENDED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT
- 2 WITH THE PRIORITIES ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 403 OF THE FEDERAL
- 3 SURFACE MINING CONTROL AND RECLAMATION ACT OF 1977.
- 4 Section 2. Procedure upon completion.
- 5 Upon completion of all abandoned mine reclamation in a coal
- 6 producing county, that county's share of the moneys may be
- 7 expended in other coal producing counties at the discretion of
- 8 the Secretary of Environmental Resources.
- 9 Section 3. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
