AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," further providing for compensation for
5 commissioners.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 703 of the act of June 24, 1931
9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569) and
11 amended November 9, 1977 (P.L.230, No.72), is amended to read:

12 Section 703. Compensation.--Each township commissioner shall
13 receive a salary of not more than [eight hundred dollars] two
14 thousand dollars per year in townships having a population of
15 less than four thousand, not more than [twelve hundred dollars]
16 twenty-four hundred dollars per year in townships having a
17 population of four thousand and more but less than ten thousand,
18 not more than [fifteen hundred dollars] twenty-seven hundred
19 dollars per year in townships having a population of ten

1 thousand and more but less than fifteen thousand, not more than
2 [twenty-four hundred dollars] thirty-six hundred dollars in
3 townships having a population of not less than fifteen thousand
4 and not more than twenty-five thousand, and not more than [three
5 thousand dollars] forty-two hundred dollars in townships having
6 a population in excess of twenty-five thousand. Such salaries
7 shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the duties imposed by
8 the provisions of this act.

9 Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1984.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
