## AN ACT

Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing limitations on telephone installation charges.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1317. Limitation on telephone installation charges.
(a) Single-line residential service.--Telephone company installation charges for single-line residential service shall not exceed four times the base monthly rate for the use of a single private line at that residential service location. This installation charge ceiling shall be the same for private, party and other single-line residential installations.
(b) Single-line business service.--Telephone company installation charges for single-line business service shall not exceed four times the base monthly rate for the use of a single private business line at that service location.
on a "call waiting" system shall not invalidate the single-line status.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
