## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for water line extensions.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 1511. Water line extensions.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 9 this title, each retail water supplier shall, upon receipt of an
- 10 application for such service in accordance with the supplier's
- 11 tariffs, rules or regulations or bylaws, be obligated to furnish
- 12 retail water service to all water-consuming facilities located
- 13 within its territory.
- 14 (b) Conditions and revenue. -- Each retail water supplier
- 15 shall file with the commission as part of its tariffs a rule
- 16 setting forth the conditions under which it will make line
- 17 extensions to supply any applicants for service within its

- 1 territory. The rule shall include a plan whereby the public
- 2 utility will construct, operate and maintain line extensions
- 3 required to serve any customer or customers who will quarantee
- 4 revenues in sufficient amount to comply with the requirements
- 5 set forth in the rule, and a statement of the terms upon which
- 6 the guarantee shall be reduced to the minimum charges as
- 7 provided in the rate schedules applicable to each class of
- 8 service supplied. Where a quarantee of revenues would be
- 9 <u>impractical or infeasible because of the limited number of</u>
- 10 customers within the proposed new service area, the supplier
- 11 shall be allowed to include the costs of the extension within
- 12 <u>its general rate base, amortized over a period of ten years.</u>
- (c) Determination of guarantees. -- In determining the
- 14 revenues originally to be quaranteed and any subsequent changes,
- 15 the following conditions shall be applicable, as appropriate:
- (1) Guarantees of revenue shall be based upon the total
- 17 <u>construction cost to the public utility of the line</u>
- 18 extension.
- 19 (2) Guarantees of revenue shall be based upon the length
- of water line required to furnish service.
- 21 (3) Guarantees shall be based upon any reasonable plan
- by which the construction cost or length of line extension or
- 23 the number of customers served or to be served from the line
- 24 <u>extension are given consideration.</u>
- 25 <u>(4) Appropriate adjustments shall be made at least</u>
- 26 <u>annually in the amount of revenue guaranteed by each customer</u>
- 27 by reason of change in the number or classification of
- 28 <u>customers supplied from the line extension.</u>
- 29 <u>(d) Service to additional customers.--Additional customers</u>
- 30 shall be connected to a line extension of a line already built

- 1 or to a further extension of a line only upon the same terms and
- 2 conditions as would apply if the extension were being made for
- 3 <u>all customers, including the new customers, provided the</u>
- 4 inclusion of new customers would not increase the quarantees of
- 5 the existing customers. If the quarantees of existing customers
- 6 would be increased, the line extension constructed to serve
- 7 additional customers shall be considered and treated as a new
- 8 and separate line extension for these additional customers.
- 9 <u>(e) Definition.--As used in this section the term "retail</u>
- 10 water supplier" means any public utility which engages in the
- 11 diverting, developing, pumping, impounding, distributing or
- 12 <u>furnishing of water to or for the public for compensation.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
