6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 6341(d) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 6341. Adjudication.

11	(d) Evidence on issue of disposition
12	(1) In disposition hearings under subsections (b) and
13	(c) all evidence helpful in determining the questions
14	presented, including oral and written reports, may be
15	received by the court and relied upon to the extent of its
16	probative value even though not otherwise competent in the
17	hearing on the petition. The parties or their counsel shall
18	be afforded an opportunity to examine and controvert written

1	reports so received and to cross-examine individuals making
2	the reports. Sources of information given in confidence need
3	not be disclosed.

4	(2) Prior to disposition the court shall request and
5	shall receive all information relating to the child from the
б	county children and youth service agency, including, but not
7	limited to all information obtained under the act of November
8	26, 1975 (P.L.438, No.124), known as the Child Protective
9	Services Law.
