## AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), entitled "An act establishing a program of limited pharmaceutical 2 3 assistance for the elderly; granting powers to and imposing duties on the Department of Aging; establishing a payment system; making provisions for funding; providing for reports; and fixing penalties for violations of the pharmaceutical 5 6 7 assistance program, "further defining "prescription drug" to include ostomy supplies. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The definition of "prescription drug" in section 12 3 of the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), known as the Pharmaceutical Assistance Contract for the Elderly Act, is
