7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The act of April 2, 1980 (P.L.63, No.26), known
9	as the Divorce Code, is amended by adding a section to read:
10	Section 505.1. Equitable distribution in certain ex parte
11	actions.
12	Whenever a person who was a resident of this Commonwealth at
13	the time such person was a defendant or respondent in a foreign
14	ex parte action for annulment or divorce petitions a court of
15	this Commonwealth for equitable distribution of property, such
16	court, if it has jurisdiction over the person or property of the
17	other party, may equitably divide, distribute and assign the
18	marital property of the parties in the same manner and under the
1 0	same conditions and limitations which pertain when equitable

- distribution of property is sought as provided in Chapter 4. In 1
- 2 the event that the respondent to such petition cannot be located
- 3 within this Commonwealth, the court may attach, distribute and
- 4 <u>assign to the petitioner such of the tangible or intangible</u>
- 5 marital property of the parties as is subject to the
- 6 jurisdiction of the court.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
