A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a Legislative advisory committee on unemployment.

2 WHEREAS, The increase in the number of unemployed citizens in
3 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, due to worldwide economic
4 conditions, has focused attention on the major problem of
5 financial uncertainty faced by the unemployed and their
6 families; and

7 WHEREAS, One of the primary attendant problems is the
8 inability of the unemployed to finance the necessary health care
9 insurance to provide for their minimum basic health care needs;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, The lack of funds for the procurement of health care
12 benefits constitutes substantial hardship to the unemployed and
13 seriously jeopardizes the financial future of the unemployed and
14 their families; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
16 shall appoint an advisory committee to identify the extent and

1 ramifications of this problem and to investigate the feasibility
2 of remedial legislative action to meet the health care needs of
3 our unemployed citizens; and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That the findings of this committee be reported to
5 the General ASsembly within 90 days of the passage of this
6 resolution.
