A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the House Transportation Committee and the House
2 Appropriation Committee to jointly investigate certain
3 activities of the Department of Transportation.

4 WHEREAS, Certain questions have arisen regarding the
5 Department of Transportation's management of State highway
6 maintenance and the funding of highway maintenance and other
7 departmental activities; and

8 WHEREAS, It would be desirable to investigate the Department
9 of Transportation in relation to the above matters; therefore be
10 it

11 RESOLVED, That the House Transportation Committee and
12 Appropriation Committee are hereby directed to jointly
13 investigate the Department of Transportation in relation to the
14 above; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the committees may hold hearings, take
16 testimony, and make their investigations at such places as they
17 deem necessary within this Commonwealth. Each member of the
18 committees shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations

1 to witnesses appearing before the committees; and be it further
2 RESOLVED, That the committees make a report of the results of
3 their investigation to the House of Representatives as soon as
4 possible.
