A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming May 1-31 as Older Americans Month.

2 WHEREAS, Nonprofit facilities for the aging in Pennsylvania  
3 are providing skilled and compassionate care for older  
4 Americans; and

5 WHEREAS, Through this care they recognize the dignity and  
6 intrinsic worth of these older Americans; and

7 WHEREAS, Nonprofit facilities for the aging provide community  
8 support of the aging through their facilities; and

9 WHEREAS, Wesley Village, a facility of the aging, has  
10 designated May 1-31 as Older Americans Month with the theme,  
11 "Communities That Care"; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly  
13 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania proclaim May 1-31, 1983 as  
14 Older Americans Month and urge the citizens of Pennsylvania to  
15 honor and celebrate this special event.
