A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the United States Congress to abandon the MX
2 missile program.

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
4 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize Congress to take
5 whatever measures necessary to discontinue the MX missile
6 program and to use the fifty billion dollars that the program
7 would cost to rebuild our Nation's railway system thereby
8 improving our Nation's transportation systems, stimulating our
9 economy, particularly employment of our citizens, and preserving
10 an invaluable industry to our Nation's well-being; and be it
11 further

12 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
13 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
14 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
