A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the Governor to proclaim the week of November
- 2 28 through December 4, 1983 as Veterans' Prayer Week.

1 WHEREAS, The League of Families of Servicemen Missing in
2 Action is sponsoring a nationwide candlelight prayer service on
3 December 4, 1983 to pray for those servicemen who are listed as
4 missing in action; and

5 WHEREAS, Various veterans' organizations, such as the
6 Pittsburgh Chapter of American Prisoners of War, the Steel
7 Valley Air Force Association (Chapter 225), the Steel Valley
8 Disabled American Veterans (Chapter 27) and Post 41 of the
9 Polish War Veterans, are joining in this observance by
10 sponsoring a prayer week, from November 28 to December 4, 1983,
11 to pray for American servicemen missing in action or killed in
12 action and for all disabled American veterans; and

13 WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
14 Pennsylvania believes it is fitting for the citizens of this
15 Commonwealth to remember our veterans, especially the disabled
16 or missing or killed in action, by observing this special week
17 of prayer, to be culminated by the nationwide candlelight
18 ceremony on December 4; therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
20 Pennsylvania memorialize the Governor of the Commonwealth to
21 proclaim the week of November 28 through December 4, 1983, as
22 Veterans' Prayer Week, to be observed by prayer for disabled
23 veterans and for American servicemen killed or missing in action
24 and to be culminated by a nationwide candlelight ceremony on
25 December 4.
