## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the Governor to appoint a committee of certain
- 2 persons to study and make recommendations on the several
- 3 problems associated with Alzheimer's dementia.
- 4 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's dementia is a presenile dementia which
- 5 afflicts many of the citizens of this Commonwealth and about
- 6 which little is known; it is an affliction which creates several
- 7 socio-economic problems within this Commonwealth, both for the
- 8 victims of the disease and for the persons charged with their
- 9 care; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
- 11 Governor appoint a committee composed of members of the medical
- 12 and health services professions who specialize in geriatric
- 13 care, of members of the Department of Health, Department of
- 14 Aging and Department of Public Welfare, of family members of
- 15 victims and of members of the General Assembly who represent
- 16 equally each chamber and each political party; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That this committee shall study and make
- 18 recommendations before December 31, 1985, on the several

- 1 problems associated with Alzheimer's dementia, including
- 2 recommendations for action to provide adequate care and support
- 3 of persons afflicted with this disease.
