### A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the Governor to appoint a committee of certain  
2 persons to study and make recommendations on the several  
3 problems associated with Alzheimer's dementia.

4 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's dementia is a presenile dementia which  
5 afflicts many of the citizens of this Commonwealth and about  
6 which little is known; it is an affliction which creates several  
7 socio-economic problems within this Commonwealth, both for the  
8 victims of the disease and for the persons charged with their  
9 care; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the  
11 Governor appoint a committee composed of members of the medical  
12 and health services professions who specialize in geriatric  
13 care, of members of the Department of Health, Department of  
14 Aging and Department of Public Welfare, of family members of  
15 victims and of members of the General Assembly who represent  
16 equally each chamber and each political party; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That this committee shall study and make  
18 recommendations before December 31, 1985, on the several

- 1 problems associated with Alzheimer's dementia, including
- 2 recommendations for action to provide adequate care and support
- 3 of persons afflicted with this disease.
