AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," authorizing appropriations for neighborhood crime
5 watch programs.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of June 24, 1931
9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is
11 amended by adding a clause to read:

12 Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first
13 class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.

14 The board shall have power--

16 LXXV. Appropriations for Neighborhood Crime Watch Programs.

1 To appropriate annually an amount toward a neighborhood crime
2 watch program. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
3 township or official thereof shall become subject to
4 contractual, tort or other liability as a result of having made
5 an appropriation pursuant to this clause.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
