## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
- 2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, " authorizing appropriations for neighborhood crime
- 5 watch programs.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of June 24, 1931
- 9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
- 10 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is
- 11 amended by adding a clause to read:
- 12 Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first
- 13 class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.
- 14 The board shall have power--
- 15 \* \* \*

- 1 LXXV. Appropriations for Neighborhood Crime Watch Programs.
- 2 To appropriate annually, SOLELY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, <---
- 3 an amount toward a neighborhood crime watch program.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no township or 4
- 5 official thereof shall become subject to contractual, tort or
- 6 other liability as a result of having made an appropriation
- 7 pursuant to this clause.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
