## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An 2 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth, "further providing for 3 registration of family day care providers-; AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Sections 1073, 1074 and 1076 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, 10 added December 5, 1980 (P.L.1112, No.193), are amended to read: 11 Section 1073. Issuance of Registration Certificate. -- Upon 12 receipt of an application and the applicant's written 13 certification of compliance with applicable department 14 regulations, the department shall be responsible for one 15 inspection visit or, in the case of agency-sponsored family day

care providers, ascertaining that an authorized family day care

agency has approved the family day care home. The department

18 shall then be responsible for completing all mandated child

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- 1 abuse clearances-, INCLUDING ANY FEE COLLECTABLE UNDER SECTION
- 2 23.1(I) OF THE ACT OF NOVEMBER 26, 1975 (P.L.438, NO.124), KNOWN
- 3 AS THE CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES LAW. The department shall
- 4 maintain the responsibility for authorizing family day care
- 5 agencies to approve family day care providers. Authorized
- 6 agencies must administer family day care programs, including the
- 7 screening and selecting of family day care providers, preservice
- 8 and inservice training, monitoring and supervision of homes,
- 9 technical assistance, and intake and placement of children. The
- 10 <u>department shall</u> issue a registration certificate to the
- 11 applicant for the premises named in the application. A
- 12 registration certificate shall be issued for a period of two
- 13 years.
- 14 Section 1074. Visitation and Inspection. -- (A) The <--
- 15 department or authorized agent of the department shall {-have the <--
- 16 right to enter, visit and inspect on a random sample basis, OR <-
- 17 upon complaint, or upon request of the care giver, any family
- 18 day care home registered or requiring registration under this
- 19 article and shall have free and full access to the premises,
- 20 where children are cared for, all records of the premises which
- 21 relate to the children's care, and to the children cared for
- 22 therein and full opportunity to speak with or observe such
- 23 children. THE DEPARTMENT OR AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 24 SHALL make a minimum of one visit before a family day care home
- 25 is registered, for the purpose of inspecting the premises. The
- 26 <u>department or agent shall obtain two written references</u>
- 27 attesting to the care giver's capability to care for children
- 28 and assessing suitability of the care giver and the daily
- 29 program to be provided, except in cases where the family day
- 30 care home has been approved as an agency-sponsored family day

- 1 care home by an authorized family day care agency. The agency-
- 2 sponsored family day care provider must have been approved by an
- 3 <u>authorized FDC agency before the home is registered.</u>
- 4 (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL ANNUALLY REPORT THE NUMBERS OF
- 5 REGISTERED FAMILY DAY CARE HOMES AND THE NUMBER OF HOMES
- 6 INSPECTED TO THE HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND
- 7 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.
- 8 Section 1076. Regulations. -- (A) The department is hereby <--
- 9 authorized and empowered to adopt regulations establishing
- 10 minimum and reasonable standards for the operation of family day
- 11 care homes and the issuance of registration certificates. These
- 12 regulations will establish the minimum standards of safety and
- 13 care which will be required in family day care homes and will
- 14 recognize the vital role which parents and guardians play in
- 15 monitoring the care provided in family day care homes. The
- 16 regulations will include, but not be limited to, the following
- 17 statements:
- 18 (1) Family day care givers must be at least twenty-one years
- 19 old.
- 20 (2) REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED FOR ANY PROVIDERS CARING FOR
- 21 TWO TO SIX CHILDREN.
- 22  $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$  (3) The number of children in care must not exceed six,
- 23 including foster children and related children, who are under
- 24 the age of six.
- 25  $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$  (4) There shall be no more than two infants (children
- 26 <u>under the age of eighteen months) in care.</u>
- 27 (4) Family day care must not be provided in facilities
- 28 located above the second floor nor in facilities located in or
- 29 <u>using areas below ground level without doors or windows.</u>
- 30 (5) THE FOLLOWING FACILITIES SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE UNLESS

- 1 THEY HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL OR A CURRENTLY VALIDATED
- 2 <u>LICENSE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY:</u>
- 3 (I) FACILITIES LOCATED ABOVE THE SECOND FLOOR.
- 4 (II) FACILITIES WHERE THE AREA ABOVE THE FIRST TWO STORIES
- 5 IS ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN.
- 6 (III) FACILITIES LOCATED IN OR USING THE BASEMENT LEVEL
- 7 (BELOW GROUND LEVEL).
- 8 (5) (6) Each FDC care giver shall have an initial medical <

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- 9 <u>examination and one annually thereafter</u>.
- 10 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALSO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS
- 11 <u>DEFINING THE SPECIFIC POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE AGENTS</u>
- 12 OF THE DEPARTMENT REFERRED TO IN SECTION 1074. THESE REGULATIONS
- 13 SHALL BE PROMULGATED WITHIN SIXTY DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 14 THIS SUBSECTION.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 16 SECTION 2. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ: <
- 17 <u>SECTION 1081. CITIZEN DAY CARE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.--(A) THE</u>
- 18 SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT A TWELVE-MEMBER CITIZEN DAY CARE
- 19 ADVISORY COMMITTEE WITH REPRESENTATION FROM ALL REGIONS AND FROM
- 20 THE KEY CONSTITUENCIES, INCLUDING PARENTS, PROVIDERS, EDUCATORS
- 21 AND CITIZEN ORGANIZATIONS.
- 22 (B) COMMITTEE MEMBERS SHALL NOT BE ENTITLED TO ANY
- 23 COMPENSATION BUT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR ALL REASONABLE AND
- 24 NECESSARY EXPENSES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE
- 25 <u>EXECUTIVE BOARD.</u>
- 26 SECTION 3. THE SUM OF \$441,250, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
- 27 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
- 28 WELFARE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1985, TO JUNE 30, 1986, FOR
- 29 ADDITIONAL STAFF TO MEET THE REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION
- 30 REQUIREMENTS TO SAFEGUARD THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF CHILDREN IN

- 1 FAMILY DAY CARE HOMES.
- 2 SECTION 4. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
