AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, eliminating the requirement of proof of insurance
- 3 for motorcycles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1305(a) and 1309 of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 1305. Application for registration.
- 9 (a) General rule.--Application for the registration of a
- 10 vehicle shall be made to the department upon the appropriate
- 11 form or forms furnished by the department. The application shall
- 12 contain the full name and address of the owner or owners; the
- 13 make, model, year and vehicle identification number of the
- 14 vehicle; and such other information as the department may
- 15 require. Applicants for registration of a truck, truck tractor,
- 16 trailer or bus shall provide the vehicle's Gross Vehicle Weight
- 17 Rating (GVWR), or the Gross Combination Weight Rating (GCWR), as
- 18 applicable. If the manufacturer's ratings are not available, the

- 1 applicant shall provide sufficient information as to the
- 2 horsepower, braking capacity and such other data as necessary
- 3 for the department to determine an equivalent measure of the
- 4 vehicle's hauling and stopping capability. If the applicant
- 5 wishes to register a vehicle at a registered gross weight less
- 6 than the gross vehicle weight rating, the application shall
- 7 include information as to weight, load and any other such
- 8 information as the department may require. The application shall
- 9 be accompanied by self-certification of financial
- 10 responsibility, except in the case of an application for
- 11 registration of a motorcycle, and the applicable fee.

- 13 § 1309. Renewal of registration.
- 14 At least 60 days prior to the expiration of each
- 15 registration, the department shall send to the registrant an
- 16 application for renewal of registration. Upon return of the
- 17 application, accompanied by self-certification of financial
- 18 responsibility, except in the case of an application for the
- 19 renewal of a motorcycle registration, the applicable fee or fees
- 20 and proof that the Catastrophic Loss Trust Fund charge has been
- 21 paid, the department shall send to the registrant a renewed
- 22 registration card. Failure to receive a renewal application
- 23 shall not relieve a registrant from the responsibility to renew
- 24 the registration.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
