## AN ACT

- 1 Requiring banks and other lending institutions to notify the
- 2 mortgagor when the mortgage has been paid.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Notice requirement.
- 6 A bank, savings bank, savings and loan association or other
- 7 lending institution holding a mortgage shall send written
- 8 notification by first class mail to the mortgagor when the
- 9 mortgage has been fully paid. Any moneys remaining in any escrow
- 10 account established for the payment of taxes or insurance
- 11 premiums shall be immediately returned to the mortgagor.
- 12 Section 2. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
