## AN ACT

- Amending the act of October 20, 1966 (3rd Sp.Sess., P.L.96, No.6), entitled "An act relating to mental health and mental retardation; authorizing county programs and amending, revising and changing the laws relating thereto and making an appropriation," further providing for the liability of the Commonwealth.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

  hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 507(a)(4) of the act of October 20, 1966
- 10 (3rd Sp.Sess., P.L.96, No.6), known as the Mental Health and
- 11 Mental Retardation Act of 1966, is amended to read:
- 12 Section 507. Liability of the Commonwealth.--(a) Except as
- 13 provided in sections 501, 502, and 505, the Commonwealth shall
- 14 pay for the following:
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 (4) [Interim care of mentally retarded persons, who have
- 17 been removed from their homes and who, having been accepted, are
- 18 awaiting admission to a State facility.] Community residential
- 19 programs for all mentally retarded persons who have been removed

- from their homes and who are living under some degree of county 1
- 2 <u>supervision and are not in State-operated facilities. This</u>
- 3 <u>includes interim care, group homes, apartments, foster homes and</u>
- 4 <u>host homes</u>.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
