## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further eliminating a mitigating circumstance in sentencing.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 9752 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 9752. Sentencing proceeding generally.

10	(c) Intoxication or drugged conditionExcept as provided
11	in sections 9711(e)(3) (relating to mitigating circumstances)
12	and 9754(c)(13) (relating to specific conditions), the condition
13	of the defendant as a result of voluntary intoxication or
14	voluntary drug usage shall not be a mitigating circumstance and
15	shall not be used by a court to reduce or shorten the sentence
16	to be imposed.
17	Section 2. This act applies to all convictions arising on or
18	after the effective date.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
