AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for limitations on insurance
3 premiums.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1793(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1793. Special provisions relating to premiums.

9 (a) Limitation on premium increases.--

10 (1) An insurer shall not increase the premium rate of an
11 owner of a policy of insurance subject to this chapter solely
12 because one or more of the insureds under the policy made a
13 claim under the policy and was paid thereon unless it is
14 determined that the insured was at least 51% at fault in
15 contributing to the accident giving rise to the claim.

16 (2) No insurer shall charge an insured who has been
17 convicted of a violation of an offense enumerated in section

1 1535 (relating to schedule of convictions and points) a
2 higher rate for a policy of insurance solely on account of
3 the conviction. An insurer may charge an insured a higher
4 rate for a policy of insurance if a claim is made under
5 paragraph (1).

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
