Section 3. The deed of conveyance shall contain clauses that 19 20 provide as follows: 21 (1) The property to be conveyed shall be used for the 22 expansion or addition of a facility or facilities at New 23 Cumberland Army Depot and if at any time the property is not 24 used for such purpose the title to the property shall 25 immediately revert to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. 26 (2) All buildings or structures erected on the property 27 conveyed shall be in compliance with the Federal Aviation

28 Administration rules and regulations and shall not interfere

29 with the use of existing runways at the Capital City Airport.

30 Section 4. The deed of conveyance shall be approved as
