AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for personal registration plates. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1341 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 1341. Personal plate.
Upon request by the applicant, including an applicant for plates under section 1344 (relating to use of farm truck plates), the department may issue registration plates consisting of any combination of numbers, letters or numbers and letters. These special plates may be issued for special groups or for special purposes and bear an appropriate designation. They shall have the same force and effect as regular registration plates. The department may refuse any combination of letters and numbers for cause and shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations for the issuance of the plates and for carrying out the provisions
of this section. The applicant shall comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to registration including the payment of any additional fees.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
