7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 515 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
9	No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
LO	amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended November 2
L1	1973 (P.L.324, No.105), is amended to read:
L2	Section 515. Compensation of Supervisors Supervisors may
L3	receive from the general township fund, as compensation,
L4	[twenty-five dollars for each meeting which they attend.] \underline{an}
L5	amount fixed by ordinance not in excess of the following:
L6	Township Population Annual Maximum Compensation
L7	Not more than 2,499 One thousand dollars
L8	2,500 to 4,999 Fifteen hundred dollars

- 5 <u>35,000 or more</u> <u>Four thousand dollars</u>
- 6 Such salaries shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the
- 7 duties imposed by the provisions of this act. The population
- 8 shall be determined by the latest available official census
- 9 <u>figures.</u> The compensation of supervisors, when acting as
- 10 superintendents, roadmasters or laborers, shall be fixed by the
- 11 township auditors either per hour, per day, per week, semi-
- 12 monthly or monthly, which compensation shall not exceed
- 13 compensation paid in the locality for similar services, and such
- 14 other reasonable compensation for the use of a passenger car, or
- 15 a two-axled four-wheeled motor truck having a chassis weight of
- 16 less than two thousand pounds and a maximum gross weight of five
- 17 thousand pounds, or a class 2 truck, having a maximum gross
- 18 weight of seven thousand pounds when required and actually used
- 19 for the transportation of road and bridge laborers and their
- 20 hand tools and for the distribution of cinders and patching
- 21 material from a stock pile, as the auditors shall determine and
- 22 approve; but no supervisor shall receive compensation as a
- 23 superintendent or roadmaster for any [day he receives
- 24 compensation for] time he spends attending a meeting of
- 25 supervisors[, unless such meeting is held after regular working
- 26 hoursl.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
