AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the utilization of headlights
- during periods of rain, snow or fog.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4302 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4302. Period for requiring lighted lamps.
- 9 Every vehicle upon a highway at any time between sunset and
- 10 sunrise, during any period of rain, snow or fog and at any other
- 11 time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric
- 12 conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly
- 13 discernible from a distance of 1000 feet ahead shall display
- 14 lighted head and other lamps and illuminating devices as
- 15 required under this chapter for different classes of vehicles,
- 16 subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles. Stop
- 17 lights, turn signals and other signaling devices shall be
- 18 lighted as prescribed in this title.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
