## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the crime of 3 rape. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3121 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 3121. Rape. 9 (a) First degree. -- A person commits [a felony of] rape in 10 the first degree when he engages in sexual intercourse with 11 another person not his spouse: 12 (1) by forcible compulsion; 13 (2) by threat of forcible compulsion that would prevent 14 resistance by a person of reasonable resolution; 15 (3) who is unconscious; or

- 10 assault as further defined in section 3128 (relating to spousal

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
