AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), entitled "An act providing for the incorporation as bodies corporate and 3 politic of 'Authorities' for municipalities, counties and townships; prescribing the rights, powers and duties of such 5 Authorities heretofore or hereafter incorporated; authorizing such Authorities to acquire, construct, improve, maintain and 7 operate projects, and to borrow money and issue bonds therefor; providing for the payment of such bonds, and 8 9 prescribing the rights of the holders thereof; conferring the right of eminent domain on such Authorities; authorizing such 10 Authorities to enter into contracts with and to accept grants 11 12 from the Federal Government or any agency thereof; and conferring exclusive jurisdiction on certain courts over 13 14 rates," further providing for the power of an authority to 15 make contracts of insurance. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 4 B(q) of the act of May 2, 1945 Section 1. 19 (P.L.382, No.164), known as the Municipality Authorities Act of 20 1945, amended August 1, 1975 (P.L.164, No.85) and repealed in

23 B. Every Authority is hereby granted, and shall have and may

24 exercise all powers necessary or convenient for the carrying out

- 2 generality of the foregoing, the following rights and powers:

- 4 (q) To make contracts of insurance with any insurance
- 5 company, association or exchange authorized to transact business
- 6 in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, insuring its employes and
- 7 appointed officers and officials under an individual policy or
- 8 policies of insurance covering life, accidental death and
- 9 dismemberment, and disability income or under a policy or
- 10 policies of group insurance covering life, accidental death and
- 11 dismemberment, and disability income provided that statutory
- 12 requirements for such group insurance, including but not limited
- 13 to requisite number of eligible employes and/or appointed
- 14 officers and officials, are met as provided for in section 621.2
- 15 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as "The
- 16 Insurance Company Law of 1921," and sections 1, 2, 6, 7 and 9 of
- 17 the act of May 11, 1949 (P.L.1210, No.367).
- 18 To make contracts with any insurance company, association or
- 19 exchange or any hospital plan corporation or professional health
- 20 service corporation authorized to transact business in the
- 21 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, insuring or covering its employes
- 22 and/or their dependents (but not its appointed officers and
- 23 officials nor their dependents) for hospital and/or medical
- 24 benefits; and to contract for its employes (but not its
- 25 appointed officers and officials) with any insurance company,
- 26 association or exchange authorized to transact business in the
- 27 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania granting annuities or to establish,
- 28 maintain, operate and administer its own pension plan covering
- 29 its employes (but not its appointed officers and officials). Any
- 30 pension plan established by a municipal authority or any annuity

- 1 contract program undertaken by a municipal authority shall meet
- 2 the applicable requirements of the act of December 18, 1984
- 3 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as the "Municipal Pension Plan Funding
- 4 Standard and Recovery Act."
- 5 For such purposes, to agree to pay part or all of the cost
- 6 thereof including the premiums or charges for carrying such
- 7 contracts, and to appropriate out of its treasury any money
- 8 necessary to pay such costs, premiums or charges, or portions
- 9 thereof. [The] <u>If otherwise in conformance with section 607(c)</u>
- 10 of the "Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery
- 11 Act," if applicable, the proper officers of the authority having
- 12 authority to enter into such contracts are hereby authorized,
- 13 enabled and permitted to deduct from the officers' or employes'
- 14 pay, salary or compensation such part of the premium or cost as
- 15 is payable by the officer or employe and as may be so authorized
- 16 by the officer or employe in writing.
