JUNE 30, 1986

AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Hahnemann Medical College and  
2 Hospital, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$4,395,000 is hereby appropriated  
6 to the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, Philadelphia,  
7 Pennsylvania, for its fiscal year July 1, 1986, to June 30,  
8 1987, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program and for  
9 participation by a representative of the institution, appointed  
10 by the chief executive officer thereof, as a member of the  
11 Pennsylvania Academic Commission on Technological Development, a  
12 commission for interinstitutional communication regarding  
13 technological innovation and development and for dissemination  
14 of information on such matters to the Pennsylvania business  
15 community and others who may use such information for new  
16 business and job development in Pennsylvania, such commission to

1 be composed of representatives of every State-owned or State-  
2 related educational or scientific institution receiving General  
3 Fund assistance from the Commonwealth.

4 (b) The sum of ~~\$204,000~~ \$454,000 is hereby appropriated to <—  
5 the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital of Philadelphia,  
6 Pennsylvania, for its fiscal year July 1, 1986, to June 30,  
7 1987, for the general maintenance of the Hahnemann Medical  
8 College and Hospital, including the Allied Health, Professions  
9 and Graduate School of the Hahnemann Medical College and  
10 Hospital, and student aid.

11 Section 2. Payments to the Hahnemann Medical College and  
12 Hospital on account of the appropriations provided in section 1  
13 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the  
14 basis of costs during the fiscal year.

15 Section 3. The Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital shall  
16 provide such information as may be necessary to carry out the  
17 provisions of this act and in such form and manner as the  
18 Department of Education shall prescribe.

19 Section 4. The Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital shall  
20 report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial  
21 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting  
22 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set  
23 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975," without  
24 exception.

25 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1986, or  
26 immediately, whichever is later.
